A. Bat Face Cuphea *Cuphea llavea*

\$8.00

Bushy, mounding perennial native to Mexico. Hummingbird attractor. The purple and red tubular flowers resemble the face of a bat and flower from spring till fall. Excellent heat and drought tolerance. PLANTS FOR TEXAS SELECTION.

SIZE: 18"X24" ZONE: 9-11 SUN: Sun to Part Shade WATER REQUIREMENTS: Low

B. 'Crimson Butterflies' Gaura *Gaura lindheimeri*

Clumping perennial native to the Mexico-USA border area. Also known as Whirling Butterflies, this selection has dark rose colored flowers that hover over crimson foliage almost year-round. Tolerant of high heat, high humidity, and drought. PLANTS FOR TEXAS SELECTION.

C. Firecracker Plant *Russelia equisetiformis*

Native to Mexico, Firecracker plant produces thin wiry-like foliage with scarlet tubular flowers from spring till fall. Great hummingbird attractor. This selection is great for containers and for producing movement in the garden. PLANTS FOR TEXAS SELECTION.

D. Gold Star Esperanza *Tecoma stans* 'Gold Star'

Gold Star Esperanza is a Texas native that is known for it's mass of tubular yellow flowers. The flowers attract hummingbirds and butterflies and produce color from spring till frost. This large shrub can be trained into a small tree. Tolerates heat, drought, and high humidity. PLANTS FOR TEXAS SELECTION.

E. Hot Lips Salvia *Salvia microphylla* 'Hot Lips'

F. Karwinskii Sage *Salvia gregii* x *karwinskii*

G. 'Ellamae' Lily-of-the-Nile *Agapanthus X 'Ellamae'*

Though Agapanthus are native to South Africa they have proven to be superstars in Texas gardens. 'Ellamae' has dark, glossy, strap-shaped leaves with flower stems producing blue/violet flowers 3' or more above the plant. Lily-of-the-Nile thrive on neglect and handle heat, drought, and humidity. Also an attractor of butterflies and hummingbirds. PLANTS FOR TEXAS SELECTION.

SIZE: 36"x36" ZONE: 7-9 SUN: Full to Part Sun WATER REQUIREMENTS: Medium to Low



H. Pink Skullcap *Scutellaria suffrutescens*

Pink Skullcap has a dense growth habit, remaining neat and compact. Pink Skullcap has small rose-red to pink flowers that virtually cover the plant from spring till fall. Skullcap is a drought tolerant, heat and sun loving perennial. PLANTS FOR TEXAS SELECTION.

I. 'Imperial Blue' Plumbago *Plumbago auriculata 'Imperial Blue'*

J. 'Tuscan Blue' Rosemary *Rosmarinus officinalis 'Tuscan Blue'*
